Completing your ONLINE Selections:

- Select from column Physical Education, REACH and 2 other courses so that there is a selection and a reserve in each row.
- Students are not able to select the same course twice.

Australian Football Specialist Program (AFSP):

- The Australian Football Specialist Program covers two option rows.
- This course is limited to students who have been offered positions in the Football Specialist Program.
- AFSP Students must choose REACH and one more course from Column 1 or 3.

Extension courses:

- Students in an extension course in 2017, may continue in the same course for 2018.
- Students in a general course in 2017, may apply for an extension course for 2018 provided they have achieved an A or B grade in the equivalent course in 2017 (eg. A or B grade in Media to apply for Media Extension).
- Students may select an extension course and a general course (e.g. Music/Music Extension).
