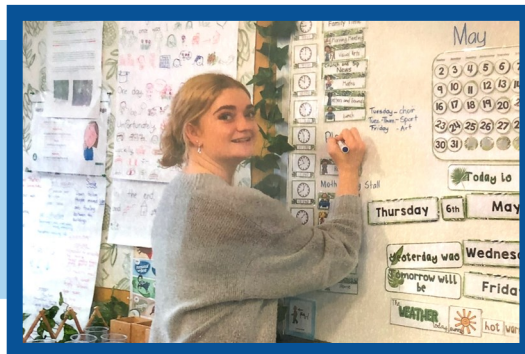




GENERAL Plus External Certificate (Fee for Service or TAFE)



Overview

Students entering this pathway are seeking alternative entry to University, TAFE or employment. You will select 4 Subjects (can include one internal certificate) plus one external course.

External VET delivery (Fee for Service and TAFE)

- ◆ All VET programs listed below are on Wednesdays. Students attend school other 4 days.
- ◆ Students select an external course from lines 5/6 of the **Year 11 Selection Sheet**.
- ◆ All of the qualifications listed below have costs attached to them. Please see the Upper School Course Selection Handbook for details.

ALL COURSES BELOW ARE SUBJECT TO MINIMUM NUMBERS OF STUDENTS TO RUN (10)

Process for entry :

- ◆ Online - Year 10 Subject Selection process (SSO) - select the General courses and the External qualification you would like to study.
- ◆ If your grades meet the criteria for entry (see below) complete an Expression of Interest (EOI) online (see back for more info)
- ◆ If your grades and EOI meet the criteria, then you and your parents will be invited to attend a Parent Night in Term 3.
- ◆ Complete application for Fee for Service courses, to relevant external Registered Training Organisation

Minimum Criteria for General plus External Certificate Pathway

- ◆ Certificate II's require C's in relevant subjects
- ◆ Certificate III's require B's in relevant subjects
- ◆ Students & Parents are required to attend a Parent Night prior to enrolment
- ◆ Good attendance 80% and behaviour record

How to apply for the General plus External Certificate (Wednesday VET Program)

1. Complete a General Selection through our online selection process (SSO) AND Select the External qualification you wish to study. **Then complete an Expression of Interest Form (EOI)**
2. Complete an **Expression of Interest Form (EOI)**
The link to this form will be available online, on the CONNECT Careers Page.
EOI Opens Wednesday, 5th June (week 8)
EOI Closes Friday, 28th June (week 11)
4. Where EOI is successful, Parents / Students will be invited to attend a compulsory Parent Night
6. Students are notified of their acceptance into their External course in term 4 2024.
